Sub.: Exemption from EIA Notification – 2006.

Dear Sir,

You had applied for your plant Gujarat NRE Coke Limited, Survey No. 227 – 230, Village: Lunva, Ta: Bhachau, Dist: Kutch to State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) on 08/04/2008 regarding your project involving Captive Power Plant of 15 MW through Waste Heat Recovery system.

The SEAC in its recommendation had said that the project is forward integration for the utilization of the waste heat and as the project is under the Clean Development Mechanism(CDM) project it would ultimately lead to sustainability of the project.

The issue was deliberated in detail at a meeting of State level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) and it was felt that no fuel was being used by the project proponent. Instead the heat of the flue gases generated from the existing coke oven plant was proposed to be used in the generation of power. Further, you had also agreed not to use any fuel to run the waste heat recovery plant, in case waste heat is not available.

After a careful consideration the authority unanimously decided to grant exemption to your plant from applicability of item no. 1(d) of the schedule of EIA notification 2006, subject to the condition that you shall not run Waste Heat Recovery based Captive Power Plant with any other fuel in any case.
